

## 109. Surah Al Kafiroon (The Misbelievers)

In the name of **ALLAH**, The Most Gracious, The Most Merciful!



قُلْ يَا أَيُّهَا الْكَافِرُونَ ﴿١﴾ لَا أَعْبُدُ مَا تَعْبُدُونَ ﴿٢﴾ وَلَا أَنتُمْ عَابِدُونَ مَا أَعْبُدُ ﴿٣﴾ وَلَا أَنا عَابِدُمَّا عَبَدتُمْ ﴿٤﴾ وَلَا أَنتُمْ عَابِدُونَ مَا أَعْبُدُ ﴿٣﴾ لَكُمْ دِينُكُمْ وَلِيَ دِينِ ﴿٦﴾

The background of this Surah is that; when the misbelievers noticed that the influence of the message of Rasool (PBUH) was increasing day-by-day and most of the people were accepting Islam; the misbelievers came up with compromising ideas; they proposed that they would not only accept the 'Almighty GOD,' of Rasool (PBUH) but also worship 'HIM' too, conditionally if (a) The Muslims also accept and worship their i.e. (Misbelievers) idols. (b) The Muslims switch to worshiping between their 'Almighty GOD,' and (The Misbelievers) God and idols, alternating worship on an annual basis. To eliminate these misleading suggestions Sura Al Kafiroon was revealed. This Surah clearly states that there is no other God but only one 'Almighty GOD' worthy of worship.
