



113. Surah Al Falaq (Daybreak)

In the name of **ALLAH**, The Most Gracious and The Most Merciful!

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

قُلْ أَعُوذُ بِرَبِّ الْفَلَقِ ﴿١﴾ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا خَلَقَ ﴿٢﴾ وَمِنْ شَرِّ غَاسِقٍ إِذَا وَقَبَ ﴿٣﴾ وَمِنْ شَرِّ النَّفَّاثَاتِ فِي الْعُقَدِ ﴿٤﴾ وَمِنْ شَرِّ حَاسِدٍ إِذَا حَسَدَ ﴿٥﴾

In this Surah, we seek **ALLAH (SWT's)** refuge by asking **ALLAH (SWT)** to provide us shelter from four things: (1) From the evil of 'HIS' creations. (2) From the evil of night's darkness. (3) From magic and evil spells. (4) From the evil of jealousy by others.; The Surah reminds us that evil is lurking everywhere and any things can become harmful. One should always be conscious, do right things and seek **ALLAH (SWT's)** protection.
