The subject of this Surah is **Towheed (The Oneness of GOD)** and **The Hereafter** . This Surah also addresses the doubts raised by the **Non-Believers** that **The Quran (GOD Forbid)** is not the word of **GOD** or **(GOD Forbid)** not revealed by **The Almighty GOD** , and **Non-Believers** also did not believe in **The Hereafter Life** and nor in **Resurrection** , accountability, rewards and punishments according to deeds done.

15 to 26: They will be seated on gold-encrusted thrones of happiness, reclining on them, facing each other. Eternal youth shall go around them. With cups and pitchers and goblets from flowing springs. Which will neither cause them headache nor adversely effect their senses. And they shall present before them every kind of tasty fruits whichever they choose. And the meat of fowl, whichever they may desire. And (with them will be their) companions pure, most beautiful eyes, as lovely as well guarded pearls. All this they receive in reward for what they have done in the world. They shall neither hear vain talk nor sinful speech. Whatever they hear shall be right and pure.

7 to 14: You shall then be divided into three categories. People of the **Right Hand**: Ah! how fortunate shall be the people of the **Right Hand**. And the people of the **Left Hand**: Oh! how unfortunate shall be the people of the left hand, and the **Foremost** shall still be **The Foremost** . They will be those who are nearest to **The Almighty God** . They shall dwell in the gardens of bliss (Pleasure). Most of them will be the former people, and some of them will be from latter times.

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
