86. Surah At-Tariq (The Night Comer/ The Piercing Star)

In this surah there are two main topics one is that there will be accountability on the **Day of Judgement**, second is that **Quran** is '**The Decisive Statement**' which cannot be harmed by any plan of disbelievers. By giving the example of heaven and stars, the way human beings came into existence, how rain brings life to various plantations on earth. **God Almighty** is warning that there is no soul without a guardian over it.

15 to 17: These people (the **disbelievers of Makkah**) are devising some plans, but I (**Almighty GOD**) too am devising a plan. So leave the disbelievers O **Prophet**' (PBUH) to themselves for awhile.

86. Surah At-Tariq

1 to 4: By the sky and what appears at night, and what do you know what appears at night? It is the shining star. There is no soul without a guardian over it.
