There are two parts of this surah; in the **first part Almighty God** is giving the examples of Sun and Moon, Day and Night, Earth and Heaven and advising on how all these have different characteristics (indications) and effects. Similarly good deeds and bad deeds have different characteristics (indications) and effects. Mankind has been created with consciousness of Good and Bad or Right and Wrong. Using the given consciousness mankind will get good results for good deeds and bad results for bad deeds. In the **second part Almighty God** is pointing to **The Guidance** in addition to consciousness provided to Mankind by **HIS** prophets. By giving a historical example of Thamud (the nation of prophet Saleh AS) who disobeyed the commandments of **Almighty God** as a result they were punished.

11 to 13: Thamud (the nation of prophet Saleh AS) belied (the Truth) as such because of their transgression (stubbornness), when the most wretched (harsh) of them rose up, in rage, The messenger of **Almighty Allah SWT** warned them, saying (do not molest) the she camel of **Allah SWT**, and (do not hinder her from) drinking water.
