Therefore, fear Allah SWT as much as you can, and listen and obey and spend your wealth wisely, this is for your own good. And those who are saved from the greed of their own heart, are truly successful. If you lend to Allah SWT a goodly loan, HE will pay you back manifold and forgive your sins. Allah SWT is Appreciative and Forbearing. HE knows the open and the hidden: HE is The Almighty, HE is The All Wise.
