In the name of **ALLAH**, The Most Gracious, The Most Merciful!

66. At-Tahreem - The Prohibition

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَٰنِ الرَّحِيمِ

This is an especially important Surah in which some incidents regarding the wives of the **Prophet (PBUH)** have been mentioned. This Surah also identifies two prominent topics: (a). Declaration of all permissions and prohibitions (Halal and Haram) are the sole authority of **Allah (SWT)** which cannot be changed by anyone including the **Prophet (PBUH)**. (b). Since any act performed by the **Prophet (PBUH)** is considered as guideline for the followers; if the **Prophet (PBUH)** committed any un-lawful act, it was not only corrected by **Allah (SWT)**, but it also got indicated and included in the Quran.

66. At-Tahreem

10 to 12: Allah SWT cites for the disbelievers the example of the wife of Noah AS and Lot AS. They were married to two of our religious servants but they betrayed their husbands, and neither of the two husbands will be of any avail to these two women when they were told (on the Day of Judgment), "Enter the Fire with all those (other sinners) who enter it. And for the believers, Allah SWT cites the example of the wife of Pharaoh, when she prayed, "My Lord, build for me, in your presence a house in paradise, and save me from Pharaoh and his wrong doings and save me from all evil doings people." And Allah SWT, cites the example of Mary AS, daughter of Imran who has guarded her chastity. So We breath into her body of Our Spirit, and she testified to the truth of her words sustainer and of His revelations, and she was one of the obedient.

8 to 9: O' you who have believed turn to **Allah SWT** in sincere repentance. (It may well be that) **Allah SWT** will remove your evils from you and admit you into **The Garden** Underneath which rivers will be flowing. It will be a Day when **Allah SWT** will not humiliate **His Prophet (PBUH)** and those who have believed with him. Their glow shall be running on before them and on their right hands, and they will be saying; O' our Lord, perfect our lives for us and forgive us: **You** have power over every thing. O' **Prophet (PBUH)** strive hard against the disbelievers and the hypocrites, and be stern with them. And (if they do not repent) their abode (destination) is Hell, and an evil abode it is.

6 to 7: O you who have believed, save yourselves and your households from a Fire whose fuel shall be the mankind and the stones, over which shall be appointed fierce and stern angles, who never disobey the commands of **Allah SWT** and they do as they are commanded (At that time it will be said) O disbeliever do not make excuses toady. You are being recompensed only for what you were doing.

1 to 2: O' **Prophet (PBUH)**, why do you make unlawful that which **Allah (SWT)** has permitted for you? (is it because you seek the goodwill of your wife?) **Allah (SWT)** is All Forgiving All Merciful. **Allah (SWT)** has already ordained for you (Muslim) the procedure for breaking and expiration* of (such of) your oaths (as may run counter to what is right and just), and **He** alone is the All Knowing, the All wise.

3: (And this is also note-worthy that) The **Prophet (PBUH)** told a matter in confidence to one of his wives. Then, when she disclosed this secret (to another), **Allah SWT** informed the **Prophet (PBUH)** (of the discloser of the secret), the **Prophet (PBUH)** made known (to the wife) part of it. So when the **Prophet (PBUH)** told his wife about he discourse, she asked, who informed you of this, The **Prophet (PBUH)** said I was informed by **Him** Who knows everything and is all aware.

4 to 5: If you both (women) repent to **Allah SWT**, (it is better for you), for your hearts swerved from the righteous path and if you supported each other against the **Prophet (PBUH)**, you should know that **Allah SWT** is his Protector, and therefore **Gabriel (AS)** and all the righteous among the believers, and all the other Angels will come to his aid. It may well be that if the **Prophet (PBUH)** divorce all of you, **Allah SWT** will give him in your place better wives, who are true **Muslims**, who are believing, obedient, patient, worshiping and fasting etc. be they previously married or virgins.

* After paying the compensation mentioned in Surah Al -Maida Ayat #8 and 9.

This is related to an incident in which Prophet (SWS) prohibited upon himself the consumption of specific honey served by one his wife due to disliking from other wives.
